

COVID-19 BOOSTER UPDATES!

The **CDC** now recommends that all people **12+ years get a booster!**

The Arizona Department of Health Services states that regardless of whichever vaccine you originally received, it is safe to receive any vaccine as a booster (Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J). All three boosters effectively protect against the Omicron variant. Read below to see which booster you can receive!

Who is eligible for a booster shot?

<u>According to the CDC</u>: individuals who received a **Pfizer or Moderna** vaccine, the following groups are eligible for a booster shot at **FIVE** months or more after their initial series:

- Pfizer: Must be 12 years or older to receive a Pfizer booster.
- Moderna: Must be 18 years or older to receive a <u>Moderna</u>
 <u>booster</u>

For those who got the **Johnson & Johnson/Janssen** vaccine, you must wait 2 months after your initial dose to receive a booster.

• You must be 18 years or older to receive a <u>J&J/Janssen booster</u>
