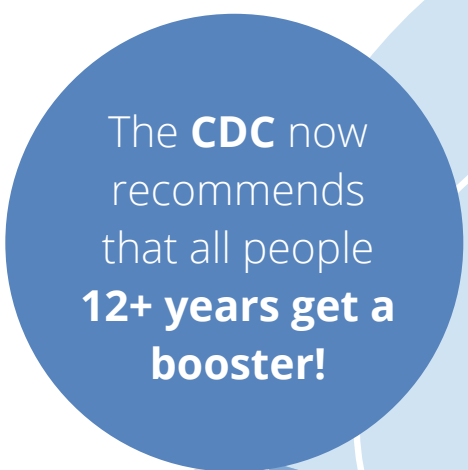

# COVID-19 BOOSTER UPDATES!



The **CDC** now recommends that all people **12+ years** get a **booster!**



The Arizona Department of Health Services states that regardless of whichever vaccine you originally received, it is safe to receive any vaccine as a booster (**Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J**). All three boosters effectively protect against the **Omicron variant**. Read below to see which booster you can receive!

## Who is eligible for a booster shot?

According to the CDC: individuals who received a **Pfizer or Moderna** vaccine, the following groups are eligible for a booster shot at **FIVE** months or more after their initial series:

- **Pfizer**: Must be 12 years or older to receive a Pfizer booster.
- **Moderna**: Must be 18 years or older to receive a Moderna booster

For those who got the **Johnson & Johnson/Janssen** vaccine, you must wait 2 months after your initial dose to receive a booster.

- You must be 18 years or older to receive a J&J/Janssen booster
