The **Pfizer vaccine** is now approved for **children 5 years old or older**. Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines are still awaiting approval to distribute to children under 18 years old.

COVID-19 vaccines remain **free of charge** to all eligible people living in the United States regardless of **immigration or health status**.
