Omicron COVID-19 Variant Protection

Arizona's hospitals and ICU beds are being overwhelmed by individuals with COVID infections due to the Delta variant of the Coronavirus, which is still very much present in our community.



The need for a 3rd COVID-19 vaccine dose (or 2nd if you got the J&J vaccine originally) is greater than ever to protect yourself from the deadly effects of the Coronavirus.

But do vaccines work against Omicron? YES!

Dr. Fauci has stated vaccines do not need re-tooling at this time to work against Omicron. Having **3 doses of Pfizer provides 90% protection** from hospitalization, while 2 doses provides less protection.

Moderna shows similar protection, and Johnson & Johnson is still under evaluation.

REMEMBER!

You can receive any vaccines for your 3rd dose regardless of your initial vaccine type.

The Arizona Department of Health Services has stated there are enough vaccines in Arizona to provide both 3rd and initial doses for all eligible Arizonans.
